We are hiring a full-time therapist to provide long-term individual and group support to people impacted by childhood sexual abuse. We believe there are many pathways to healing and are seeking a therapist who brings an Indigenous approach to walking alongside people in their healing journey.

Salary: \$50,000 - \$55,000 to start (35-hour work week)

Main Responsibilities:

- Provide individual therapy for people who have experienced childhood sexual abuse
- Provide support, referral, and advocacy as appropriate
- Develop and facilitate process and psychoeducational groups and workshops

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary education in social services or related field and/or combinations of relevant education and experience
- Experience providing individual and group counselling to people impacted by trauma, addictions, and/or mental health challenges
- Brings Indigenous knowledge and values to the therapeutic relationship and healing spaces.
- Demonstrated understanding of addiction, mental health, and unresolved trauma related to childhood sexual abuse
- Working knowledge of a wide range of healing approaches from diverse worldviews
- Strong organizational, planning, and time management skills
- Non-judgmental and accepting attitude, with the ability to maintain client confidentiality
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Computer skills - Microsoft Word, Excel, and Outlook
- Satisfactory Criminal Record and Child Abuse Registry Check
