- Working knowledge of a wide range of healing approaches from diverse worldviews.
- Awareness of anti-oppressive practice in the helping profession.
- Strong organizational, planning, and time management skills.
- Non-judgmental and accepting attitude with the ability to maintain client confidentiality.
- Computer skills: Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check.
